He empathizes with him, is honest with him, supports TMJ4's "[Moving Forward](#)" initiative, encourages him to keep grinding, does his best to be helpful (even going so far as to contact his former employer), and treats Justin with the utmost respect. This is night and day compared to how some of Justin's other inquiries were treated. Justin was especially thankful and immensely touched by these conversations.

It is interesting to note that he says that anything reported was simply based on the criminal complaint (i.e., police report). This is a practice that seems to consistently lead to issues. Not providing both sides of a story in a news report can have the potential to mislead the reader/viewer.

I apologize for not responding sooner...I honestly missed the initial couple emails. I get a lot of spam, or different companies trying to send work my way.

That said, if there was something that was proven to be false or wrong after the first couple stories aired...I understand why you have a desire to get things taken down. Everything that was reported in any stories I had, was obviously just based off of the criminal complaints/investigators in the early stages.

I don't have a ton of major ties at the station anymore as many people have come and gone. All I can do for you is pass along the request and mention you reached out to me. [REDACTED] owns all of the content and I'm not sure what their policy is. If something was deemed factually incorrect, legally (with the help of a lawyer?) I imagine it would have to be taken down. But again, not my area of expertise.

I did check my old work Facebook page, and I didn't have any articles related to the reports.

I always believed in the human side of life over just "getting a story" ...so I truly wish you and your family the best of luck today, and in the future as you move forward.
